- Donation receptacles to collect items for supply drives do not need to be elaborate!
- They can be as simple as a corrugated box or a pressed cardboard barrel if you have them available.
- As you can see from the photo above, your display can be simple, clean, and functional.
- Displaying donation envelopes near your donation receptacle(s) is very helpful for those people who are not shoppers.

### **Fundraising Ideas**

Here you will find multiple fundraising ideas, including bake sales, raffles, etc. These activities can accompany your organization's supply drive to help raise a greater amount of money and supplies for Crayons to Classrooms, which in turn will benefit students across the Miami Valley.

### **Fundraising Ideas to Accompany Supply Drives**

#### **1. SUNDAE ON A MONDAY**

• Why not start the work week off with an ice cream treat? Sell packaged treats or have a committee dip and serve. This event is bound to raise spirits at the office on a warm summer Monday afternoon!

### 2. BAKE SALE

 Who doesn't love a bake sale? Ask for donations of baked goods, have a committee price and sell them along with fresh-brewed coffee to start a morning at the office off right.

#### **3. RAFFLE**

• Purchase a gift card to a great restaurant, store, etc. and sell raffle tickets for \$1 each or 6 tickets for \$5. All profits can be donated to Crayons to Classrooms.

#### 4. "DRESS-DOWN" DAYS

• Approach work in a relaxed fashion — invite employees to "pay" to wear jeans to work through a donation to Crayons to Classrooms.

#### **5. GARAGE SALES**

 Host an internal garage sale. Everyone cleans out a few items that they no longer need at home to donate. The sale can be set up in a conference room, etc. All proceeds can benefit Crayons to Classrooms!

#### **6. COLORING CONTEST**

• Invite employees to "purchase" a coloring page for their children to decorate. These can be posted in the office to add a bit of cheer to the workplace. Proceeds will support Crayons to Classrooms.

#### 7. CORN HOLE TOURNAMENT

• Host a lunchtime corn hole tournament. Forming teams is fun and a minimal registration fee can be used to help raise funds for a worthy cause!

#### 8. BROWN BAG IT

• Encourage fellow co-workers to bring their lunch from home and donate the money saved from skipping on a lunch out to Crayons to Classrooms.

#### 9. CHANGE DRIVES

• Employees accumulate loose change over a designated period of time and donate it to Crayons to Classrooms. Adding a competitive aspect between departments is always a fun twist!

#### **10. SCHOOL LUNCH**

• Plan and host a "school lunch" event. Make the space look festive and re-live the years of PB&Js and bologna and cheese sandwiches! Fellow coworkers can purchase a "lunch ticket" to join the fun!
