

SHOPPER ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Who qualifies?

Crayons to Classrooms (C2C) serves schools with 60% or more of their students participating in the National School Lunch Program. Additionally, C2C serves select schools in rural counties based on median income. C2C promotes the full participation of certified teachers from qualified schools within the following counties: Clark, Darke, Greene, Miami, Montgomery, Preble, and north Warren County. Schools are added to the C2C eligibility list on an individual basis as determined by the organization.

Only **<u>certified</u>** teachers at eligible schools are invited to shop. This includes principals, assistant principals, general education teachers, intervention specialists, and specials teachers such as physical education, music and art teachers. Who does not qualify?

The following positions are <u>not</u> eligible to shop:

- Administrative Staff
- Support Services (Secretaries/Nurses)
- Aides
- Paraprofessionals
- Curriculum Coaches
- School Counselors

- Speech and Language Pathologists
- Social Workers
- Physical Therapists
- Occupational Therapists
- School Psychologists

How often can a teacher shop at C2C?

Teachers from schools served by C2C are eligible to shop once during first semester (August-November) and once during second semester (January-May). Teachers are **required** to schedule their shopping visits online by visiting: <u>https://teachersfreestore.com/dayton/</u>. Usernames and passwords will be provided to each teacher by C2C.

One extra shopping visit per academic year can be earned via volunteerism. Therefore, teachers are eligible for a <u>maximum of three shopping visits per year</u>. For more information on our Volunteer to Shop program visit: <u>https://www.crayonstoclassrooms.org/teachers/volunteer-to-shop/</u>

Teachers who teach at multiple eligible schools within the same school district are also eligible to shop once per semester. However, these teachers will only be listed under a single school in the district. C2C will determine which school they will be listed and shopping for, based on which school receives more of their time.
