\$40.9 Million Worth of Free School Supplies Put Into Classrooms Since 2009

Every notebook, pencil, marker, and backpack tells a story. Behind the \$40.9 million in free school supplies are countless moments where a student had the tools to learn, a teacher felt supported, and a classroom was equipped for success. Each marker uncapped, notebook filled, and backpack zipped reflects the generosity of our donors, partners, and volunteers who make this impact possible.



By the Numbers: Our Reach in 2024-25

Last school year, we welcomed teachers from **130** schools and **13** childcare centers across the Miami Valley. Eligible teachers can shop at our Resource Center once per semester—resulting in **3,777** total shopping visits during the year.

On average, each visit saved a teacher **\$678** in classroom expenses. For those who take advantage of every available resource, that value can exceed **\$2,000** in supplies—directly supporting their students and classrooms.
